



ARDEN PENDANT
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This stunning pendant is reversible and colorful and matches your mood!

Project Level: intermediate and up

Techniques Used: Familiarity with Right angle weave and stitching with multi hole beads

Finished Size: About 2 inches diameter

MATERIALS

2 grams size 15° seed beads

1 gram size 11° seed beads

6 Fixer Beads with Vertical holes (F)

18 GemDuos color 1 (G1)

18 GemDuos color 2 (G2)

18 Czech druks/Pearls 4mm (P)

12 Swarovski crystal bicones 3mm color 1 (C1)

12 Swarovski crystal bicones 3mm color 2 (C2)

12 Swarovski crystal bicones 3mm color 3 (C3)

12 Swarovski crystal bicones 4mm color 4 (C4)

1 Bail closed

6lb Fireline

Size 12 beading needle

Scissors or thread zapper

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TIPS

- This project uses Fixer beads with Vertical holes. The fixer beads come with horizontal holes as well. Please check which kind you are getting, before you purchase them.
- It is important to make sure none of the holes are blocked when you work with multihole beads. Checking before you start the project is essential and will save you from tearing it down halfway through.
- Druks/pearls can be substituted with Fire polished beads. It will give it a different texture overall.

FIGURE 1

Step 1. Cut about a wingspan of thread and leave 10-12-inch tail to use later. Pick up 4P and go back through all the beads again. Tie a double knot with the tail and go through the first P. This is your first Right-angle weave (RAW) box.

Step 2. Pick up 3P and go back through the bead you are coming out of. Step up by going through the next 2P. This is the second RAW box. Continue adding RAW boxes until you have a total of 5. **(Fig. 2a-b)**

Step 3. Bring the two ends together. We will now connect the two ends with another RAW box. Pick up 1P and go through the P on the other end. Pick up 1P and go back through the P you started from. This is the last RAW box. Reinforce the thread path one more time and step up to come out of one of the side P. **(Fig. 2c-2f)**

Step 4. Pick up 1A and go through the next side P. Repeat all the way around and reinforce once more. Come out of an A. **(Fig. 3a-b)**

Step 5. Pick up 1A-1C1-1F (hole on the right)-1B-3G1-1B and go down the hole on the left of the F. Keep the thread tight. Pick up 1C1-1A and go through the next A on the RAW circle. Come up the A you just added. Keep the thread tight. **(Fig. 4a-d)**

NOTE: The right and left hole should be on the same ridge of the fixer. And the GemDuos should face outwards.

FIGURE 5

Step 6. This time pick up 1C1-1F-1B-3G1-1B and go through the left hole of the F. Pick up 1C1-1A and go through the next A on the RAW circle. **(Fig. 5a-b)**

Step 7. Repeat until you have 5 of these petals on. For the last petal, You will share the A (below the C1) from both the neighboring petals. You will be going through the first A on the RAW circle you started from. **(Fig. 5c-g)**

FIGURE 6

Step 8. Leave the working thread aside. Thread a needle to the tail and flip to the back. Come out of a side P and repeat Steps 4, 5 and 6 using G2 and C2 for this side. **(Fig 6a-b)**

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NOTE: If your tail thread is too short at this point, weave it into the RAW base and tie it off. If not, we can continue. We will now embellish the G2 side first.

FIGURE 7

Step 9. Come out of the first G2. Go through the outer hole of the G2. This will reverse the direction of beading. Pick up 1C3 and go through the first G2 of the next petal. Keep the thread tight. **(Fig 7-c)**

Step 10. Pick up 1B-1C4-1B1 and go through the next G2 of the same petal. Repeat once more. **(Fig 8a-c)**

Step 11. Alternate Steps 9 and 10 all the way around. Come out of a C4.

FIGURE 10

Step 12. Pick up 1B and go through the next G1. Pick up 1B and go through the next C4. Again, pick up 1B and go through the next G1. This will connect the two sides to each other whilst centering the C4. **(Fig. 10a-e)**

Step 13. Pick up 1C3 and go through the next G2. Repeat this step all the around. Step up by coming out of 1B-1C4-1B. **(Fig 10f-g)**

Step 14. We will now attach the bail. Pick up 9B-1Bail and go down through the 1B-1C4-1B on the other side.

FIGURE 11

Step 15. Weave all the way around and when you come up to the bail, come through the G2 side. This will center the bail loop. Weave all the way around on the G2 side. This will strengthen the pendant. Tie half hitch knots along the way and cut off thread. **(Fig 11a-d)**

The pendant is finished!

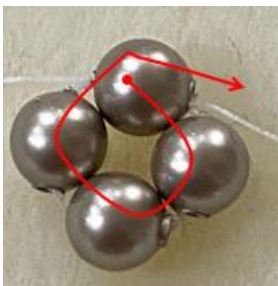

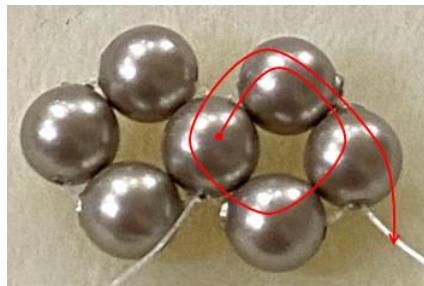

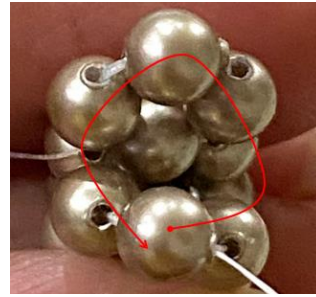

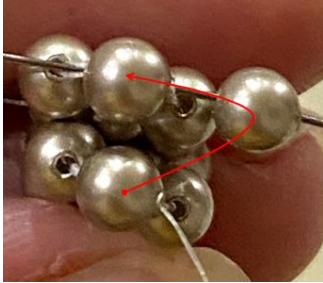

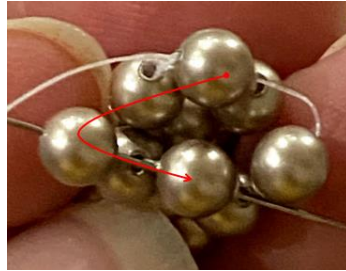

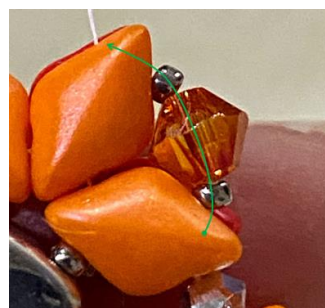

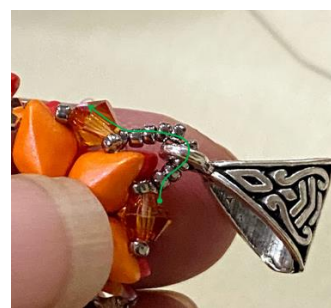
