



NAVETTE BEADED BEAD

Who doesn't love making and creating jewelry with beaded beads?

Skill level: Advanced beginner and up

Techniques: Stitching with two-hole beads

Finished size: 2" diameter

MATERIALS for one beaded bead

108 size 11° Delica beads

30 size 11° seed beads

12 SuperDuos

6 Navette beads

6 True2™ 2mm fire polish round beads

6lb Fireline or D weight beading thread

Size 11 beading needle

Scissors/Thread Zap

TIPS

- Be sure all holes are clear before using multi-hole beads
- Retraced thread paths are not shown in the illustrations for clarity.

STEP 1. Using a 50" piece of thread, pick up one 11° and one SuperDuo six times. Pass through all the beads a second time forming a circle and leaving a six-inch tail thread. Tie a half hitch knot around the thread. Pass through the first 11°, SuperDuo and the second 11° one more time. Step up into the open hole of the next SuperDuo.

STEP 2. Pick up one Delica, one Navette (end hole) and one Delica. Pass through the open hole of the next SuperDuo. Repeat five more times. Make a second pass through all the beads added in this step. Exit from a Navette and pass through the second hole of the same bead.

NOTE: This step is worked in the opposite direction from the previous step.

STEP 3. Pick up one 11° and pass through the middle hole of the next Navette. Repeat five times. Pull beads closed together to form a tight cylinder shape. Pass through the first 11° and next Navette a second time, then pass through the open hole of the same Navette the thread just exited.

STEP 4. Pick up one Delica, one SuperDuo, one Delica. Pass through the open hole of the next Navette. Repeat five more times. Pass through the first Delica a second time. Step up to the open hole of the next SuperDuo.

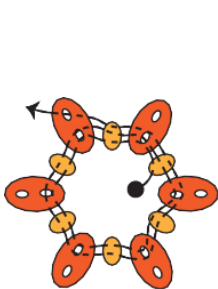
STEP 5. Add one 11° between the open hole of each SuperDuo, for a total of six beads. Make two more passes through all the beads using firm tension. Tie a half hitch knot around the thread. Pass through another 11° and exit from the first hole (will now be exterior edge position) of the next Super Duo.

NOTE: The beadwork is shown from the side view in the following steps.

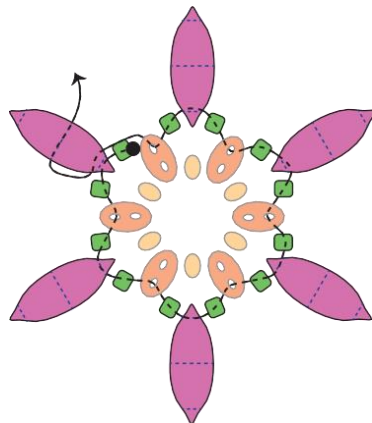
STEP 6. Pick up three Delicas and pass through the center 11°. Pick up three Delicas and pass through the lower SuperDuo. Pick up three Delicas and pass through the center 11° from the opposite direction. Pick up three Delicas and pass through original SuperDuo, the Delica, Navette, Delica and next SuperDuo. Repeat five times. Exit from Navette.

STEP 7. Pass through the beads to exit from a center 11°. Pick up one Delica, one 11°, one True2, one 11° and one Delica. Pass through the next center 11° bead. Repeat five times. Reinforce by passing through all the beads just added. Tie threads off and trim.

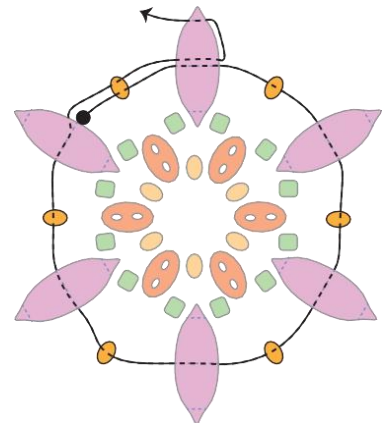

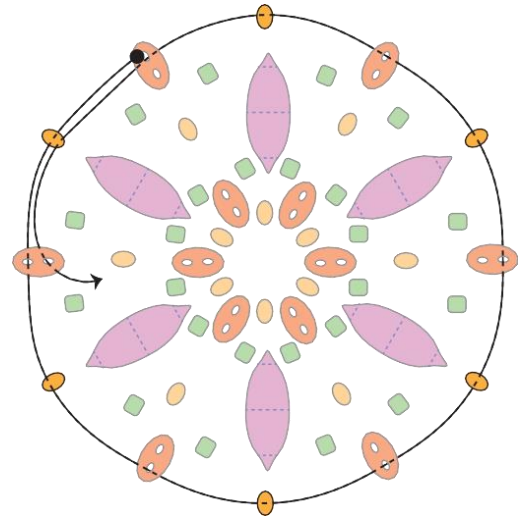

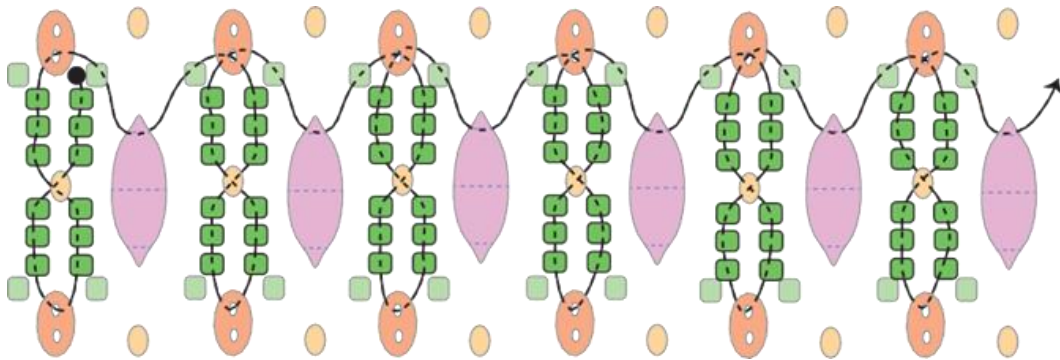
