



BAROQUE WAVES BRACELET & EARRINGS

Skill Level: Intermediate

Techniques: right angle weave, picot, fringe, familiar with multi-hole beads

Finished size: Bracelet 6 1/2" (16.5cm) Earrings 1 5/8" x 5/8" (4x2.5cm)

MATERIALS

1 gram size 15° seed beads

0.5 grams 11° seed beads

1 gram 2.8mm Drop beads

1 gram 2mm Fire polished rounds

36 x 4mm Fire polished rounds

21 x 7mm Baroque cabochon (2-hole)

6 grams Wave beads (2-hole)

2 x 4mm open jump rings

1 x 16mm toggle clasp

Pair of ear wires

6lb. Fireline™

Scissor/pliers

Designer notes:

- Check all holes of Baroque cabochons and Wave beads, to make sure they are clear before stitching.
- This project uses a lot of thread, use the method that you are comfortable with to end and add thread.

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BRACELET

Step 1

Center Row. Use right-angle weave to form the center row. On a comfortable length of thread, string one 15°, one Wave bead (concave side, top hole), one 15°, one Wave (convex side, top hole), one 15° and one baroque cab (left hole) twice (**red thread**). Sew through the beads again (same holes) to form a circle, leaving a 3" tail. Tie the working and tail threads into a square knot. Sew back through the next six beads (same holes) exiting up from the left hole of first baroque cab added in this unit of beads. Sew down through the right hole of the same bead (**black thread**).

Step 2

String one 15°, one Wave (concave side, top hole), one 15°, one Wave (convex side, top hole), one 15°, one baroque cab (left hole), one 15°, one Wave (concave side, bottom hole), one 15°, one Wave (convex side, bottom hole) and one 15°. Sew through the right hole of the baroque cab exited (**red thread**). Sew through the next 6 beads, exiting up from the left hole of the baroque cab added in this unit of beads. Sew down through the right hole of the same bead (**black thread**).

Step 3

Repeat Step 2 14 more times, to add a total of 17 baroque cabs, exiting down through the left hole of the last baroque cab added.

Step 4

First clasp loop. String one 11°, eight 15°, one 11° and sew back through the baroque cab exited (same hole). Sew up through the left hole of the same bead (**red thread**). String two 15°s and sew through the top hole of next Wave (**black thread**).

Step 5

Outer Rows. String one 4mm fire polish and sew through the top hole of the next Wave (**blue thread**). String one 11° and sew through the top hole of the next Wave (**fuchsia thread**). Repeat these stitches to complete this edge of the bracelet (**brown thread**). On the last repeat, string two 15°s and sew through next 15°, the right hole of next baroque cab and up through the left hole of the same bead (**black thread**).

Step 6

Second clasp loop. String one 11°, eight 15°, an 11° and sew back through the baroque cab exited (same hole). Sew down through the right hole of the same bead and next 15° (**red thread**). String two 15°s and sew through the top hole of the next Wave (**black thread**).

Step 7

Repeat Step 5 to complete this edge of the bracelet. Retrace the previous thread path to exit from first two 15°s added on Step 4.

Step 8

String five 15°s and sew through the next 4mm (**blue thread**). String one 11°, one 2mm fire polish, one 11° and sew through next 4mm (**red thread**). Repeat these stitches to complete this edge of the bracelet (**brown thread**). On last repeat, string five 15°s and sew through next two 15°s (**black thread**).

Step 9

String one 2mm and sew through next 10 beads of the second clasp loop (**red thread**). String one 2mm and sew through the next two 15°s (**black thread**).

Step 10

Repeat Step 8 to complete this edge of the bracelet. Exit from last set of two 15°s.

Step 11

String one 2mm and sew through the next 10 beads of first clasp loop (**red thread**). String one 2mm and sew through the next seven 15°s (**black thread**).

Step 12

String three 15°s, one drop and sew through the next 11°, 2mm and 11° (**red thread**). Repeat this stitch to complete this edge of the bracelet (**blue thread**). On last repeat, sew through next five 15°s (**black thread**).

Step 13

String one drop, skip the next two 15°s and sew through the next 12 beads. Exit the next 2mm (**red thread**). String one drop, skip the next two 15°s and sew through following five 15°s (**black thread**).

Step 14

Repeat Step 12 to complete this edge of the bracelet.

Step 15

String one drop, skip the next two 15°s and sew through the next 12 beads. Exit the next 2mm (**red thread**). String one drop, skip the next two 15°s and sew through the following eight 15°s. Secure the thread and trim it (**black thread**).

Step 16

Use an open jump ring to attach one half of the clasp to one end of the bracelet. Repeat on the other end.

EARRINGS

Step 17

Repeat Step 1. Turn the beadwork so the baroque cab is at the top and thread is exiting from the top hole of this same bead. String four 15°s and sew through the next Wave, 4mm and Wave (**red thread**). String four 15°s and sew through the bottom hole of the next baroque cab (**blue thread**). Repeat these stitches, then exit from first four 15°s added in this round (**black thread**).

Step 18

String four 15°s and sew through the next 4mm (**red thread**). String four 15°s and sew through the next four 15°s (**blue thread**). String two 15°s, one 11°, one 2mm, one 11°, two 15°s and sew through the next four 15°s (**orange thread**). Repeat these stitches and exit from the first four 15°s added in this round (**black thread**).

Step 19

String one drop, three 15°s and sew through the next four 15°s (**blue thread**). String one 11°, one 2mm, one 11°, skip the next four 15°s and sew through the following beads: two 15°s, one 11° and one 2mm (**fuchsia thread**). String five 15°s, one baroque cab (left hole) and five 11°s, sew up through the right hole

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of the baroque cab (**orange thread**). String one 15°, skip one 15° of the previous set of five 15°s and sew through the next two 15°s (**green thread**). String two 15°s and sew back through the exited 2mm, next 11° and two 15°s (**purple thread**). String one 11°, one 2mm, one 11°, skip the next four 15°s and sew through the next four 15°s (**brown thread**). String three 15°s, one drop and sew the through next 12 beads. Exit from the 2mm at the top of the earring.

Step 20

Loop. String six 15°s and sew back through the 2mm exited, to form a loop. Repeat the thread path through the loop to reinforce, secure the thread and trim it.

Step 21

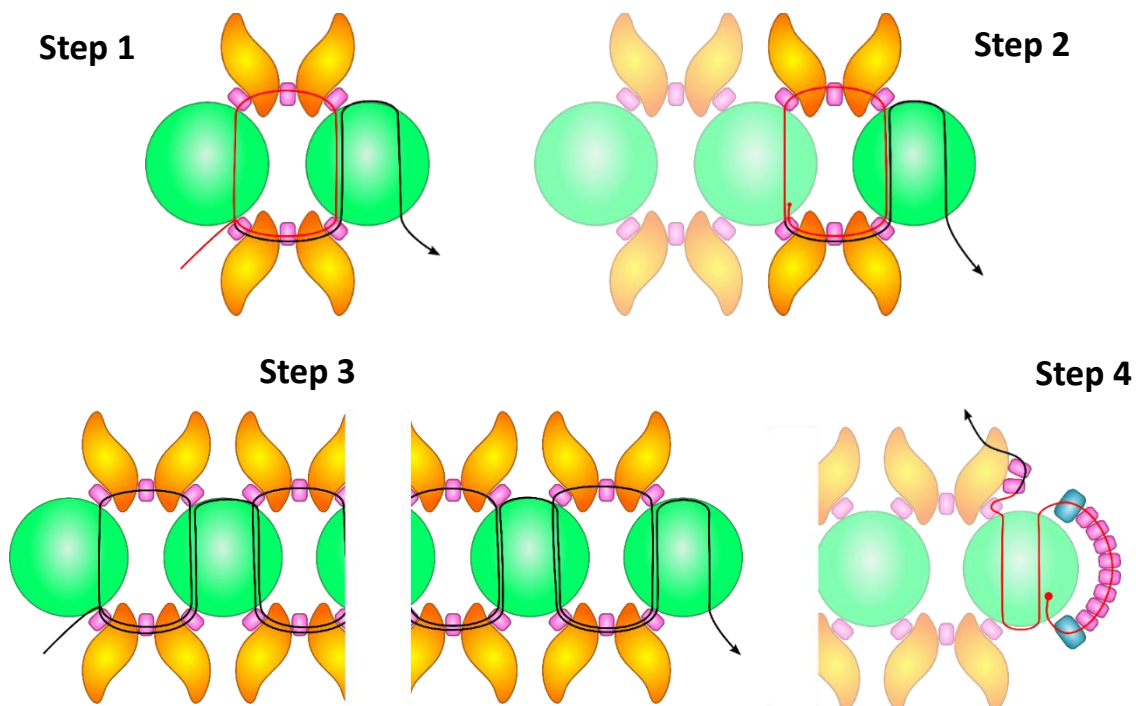
Stitch a second earring repeating Steps 17 through 20. Attach an ear wire to the loop to complete the pair.
