



'KALANI' BRACELET

Skill Level: Intermediate

Techniques to know: peyote stitch, picot, fringe

Finished size: 6.9" x 1.2"

MATERIALS

1.5 grams size 15° seed beads

0.5 grams size 11° seed beads

0.5 grams size 11° Delicas

20 x size 3mm fire polish

48 x size 4mm fire polish

20 x Ginko beads

12mm ball magnetic clasp

4lb. Fireline™

size 12 beading needle

Scissors

FIRST END COMPONENT

Step 1. Use 4' of thread to string one 11° and one 4mm fire polish four times. Sew through all the beads again to form a tight circle, leaving a 4" tail. Tie a square knot between the tail and working threads and then exit from an 11°.

Step 2. String one 15°, five 11°, one 15° and sew through the next 11° (**red thread**). Repeat this stitch three times, retrace the previous thread path to exit the first three 11° added in this round (**black thread**).

Step 3. String one 15°, one Ginko bead (pointed side, right hole), one 15°, three 11°, one 15° and sew through the left hole of the Ginko (**red thread**). String one 11°, one 4mm, one 11° and sew through the next center 11° (**blue thread**). Repeat these stitches three times, retrace the previous thread path to exit the third 15° added in this round (**black thread**).

Step 4. String four 15° and sew through the next 11°, 4mm and 11° (**red thread**). String three 15°, one 3mm fire polish and sew through the next 15°, three 11°s and one 15° (**blue thread**). Repeat these stitches three times. On the last repeat, sew only through the next 15° and 11° (**black thread**).

Step 5. String three Delicas; skip the center 11° and sew through the next 11° and five 15°s (**red thread**). String four Delicas and sew through the next three 15°s, 3mm, 15° and 11° (**blue thread**). Repeat these stitches three times, retrace the previous thread path to exit the first three Delicas added in this round (**black thread**).

FIRST BEADED END ARC

Step 6. String 17 Delicas and sew through mirror two Delicas at the bottom left of the component.

Step 7. String three 15°s and sew back through the last 11° added (**red thread**). Work eight stitches in peyote with one 11° in each stitch and sew through the next two Delicas (**black thread**).

Step 8. String three 15°s and sew back through the previous two 11°s (**red thread**). Work three stitches in peyote with two 15°s in each stitch (**blue thread**). String one half of the clasp and sew through the next 11° (**fuchsia thread**). Work three stitches in peyote with two 15°s in each stitch, retrace the previous thread path, secure the thread and trim it (**black thread**).

SECOND END COMPONENT

Repeat Steps 1 to 8 to form a Second end component.

MIDDLE COMPONENTS

Step 9. Repeat Steps 1 to 5 three times to form three middle components. Do not trim the working thread on these middle components. **NOTE:** The working thread should be exiting the third Delica over the Ginko facing the inside of the component.

BRACELET ASSEMBLY

Step 10. Lay one end component (Component A) and one of the middle components (Component B) side by side on your work surface. String one 15°, one 4mm, one 15° and sew through two mirror Delicas of Component A (**red thread**). String one 11° and sew through the next 4mm (**blue thread**). String one 11° and sew through the middle and end Delicas of Component B. Retrace the previous thread path to exit from the middle and end Delicas at the bottom of Component B (**brown thread**). Repeat the thread path once, secure the thread and trim it.

Step 11. Join the remaining components as in Step 10 to complete the bracelet.

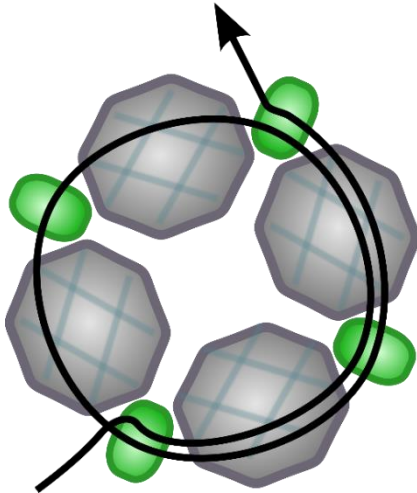

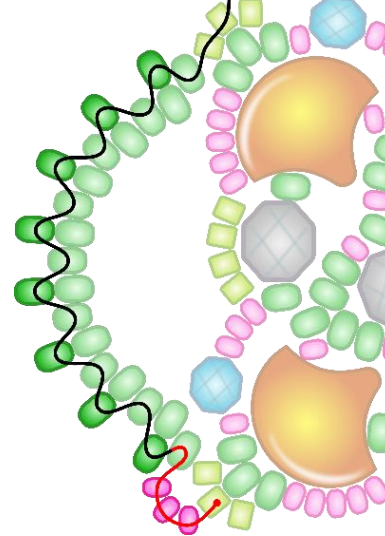

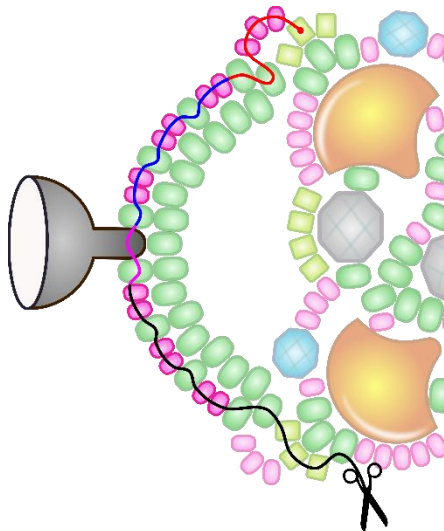

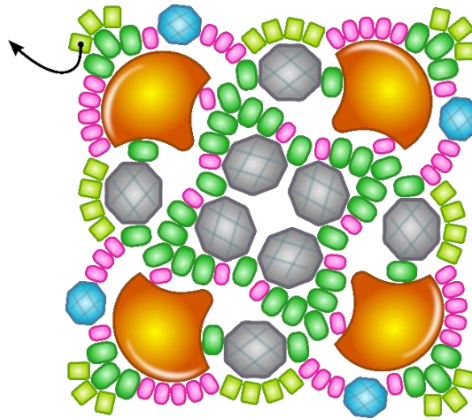

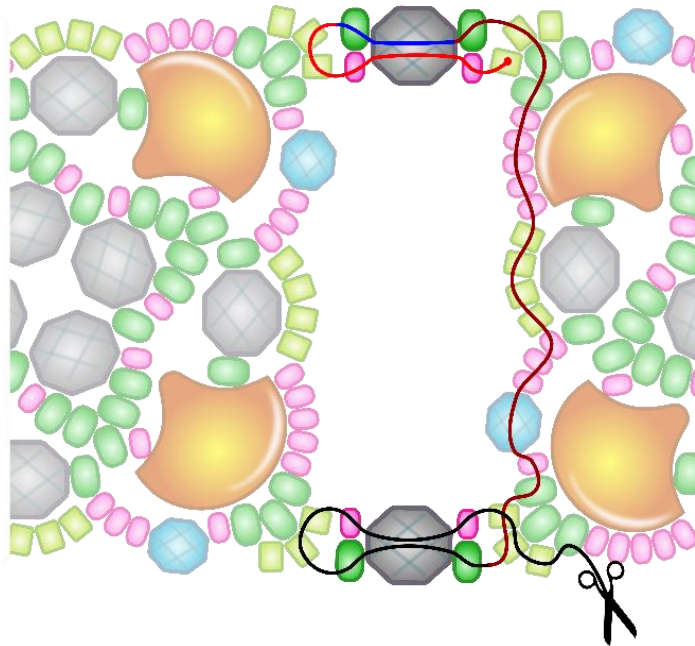
