



**KAYLA COLLAR**  
by Cora Sparidaans  
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**Skill level:** Confident beginner

**Techniques:** Stitching with multi-hole beads

**Finished length:** 14½" (47cm) excluding the clasp

**MATERIALS**

6g size 15° seed beads

2g size 11° seed beads

26 Ginkos

27 faceted microspacers

27 Navette beads

30 size 3mm round beads

54 Bridge beads

1 toggle clasp

2 size 5mm jump rings

6lb. Fireline

Size 12 beading needle

Scissors/Pliers

**TIP**

- Check that all holes of any multi-hole beads are not clogged before stitching.

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**FIGURE 1**

**Step 1.** Pick up one Bridge, one Navette, one Bridge and one 3mm. Repeat this for a total of 27 Navettes or desired length.

**FIGURE 2**

**Step 2.** After the last Bridge, pick up one 3mm, one microspacer, one 11°, five 15°, one 11°, one microspacer, one 3mm and sew through the third hole of the Bridge, Navette and next Bridge.

**FIGURE 3**

**Step 3.** Pick up one Ginko (refer to illustration for correct position) and five 15°. Sew through the next hole of the Ginko, the third hole of the next Bridge, Navette and Bridge.

**Step 4** (not illustrated). Repeat Step 3 the entire length. (The necklace will start to curve.)

**FIGURE 4**

**Step 5.** After the last Bridge, pick up one 3mm, one microspacer, one 11°, five 15°, one 11°, one microspacer, one 3mm and sew through the first hole of the Bridge and Navette.

**Step 6.** Pick up three 15°, one 11°, one microspacer, one 11° and three 15°. Sew through the Navette third hole opposite side (refer to illustration for correct position).

**FIGURE 6**

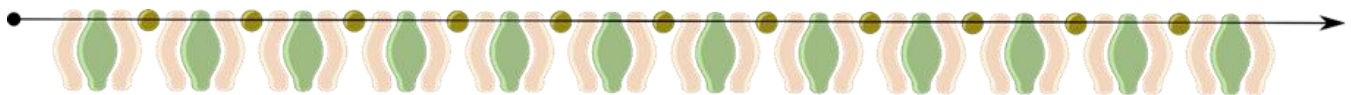
**Step 7.** Pick up three 15°, one 11° and sew through the microspacer. Pick up one 11°, three 15°s and sew through the first hole of the Navette. This makes an "X" on top of the Navette.

**Step 8** (not illustrated). Repeat Step 7 the entire length of the necklace.

**Step 9.** Secure the thread within the beadwork with half hitch knots and trim the excess. Attach the clasp with jump rings at the beaded loops.

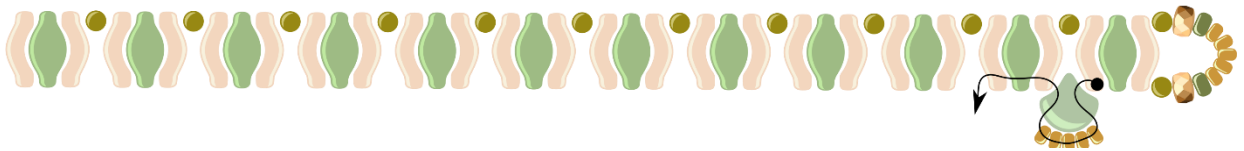

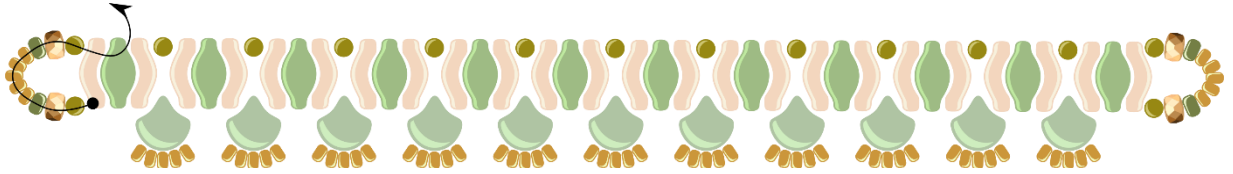

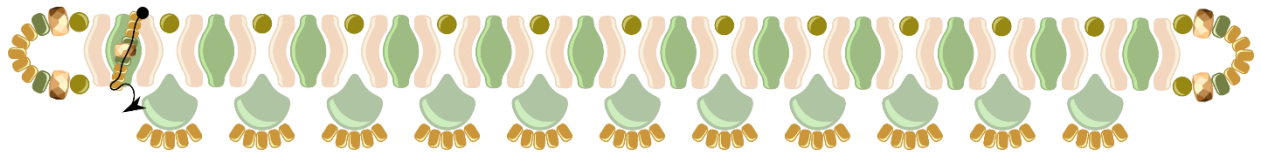

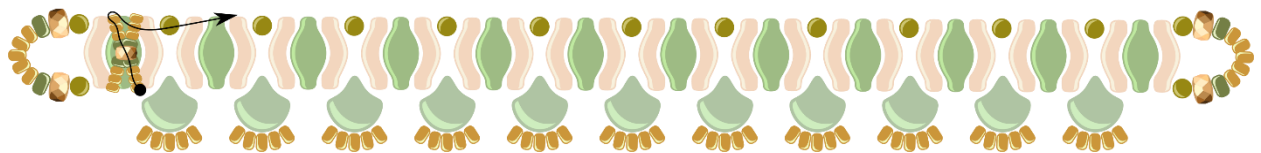
