



Skill Level: Intermediate and up

This bracelet design can be created with segments of two or four tiles. Use Miyuki seed beads for this project. The charm of this design comes from using different colors of beads as you would see in a quilt.

Of course, you can make each tile in the same colors. The supply list reflects the total amount of each bead size needed for the project. It's entirely up to you how you want to arrange/distribute the colors. I color-match the Delicas with the 4mm rounds. The size 11 and 15 seed beads I use are the same color, although I have often used a different color 15. (Duracoat metallics are a nice fit.

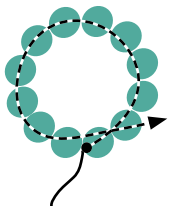
SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR A 6.5" BRACELET

- 16+ 4mm druks or pearls
- *1g size 11 MYUKI Delicas
- 4g size 11 MIYUKI rounds
- 1g size 15 Miyuki rounds
- 16+ Topolia III Cymbal ends
- 16+ jump rings (18 g or 20g)
clasp
- Size 11 beading needle
- 6lb Fireline thread

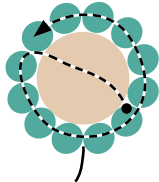

Thread your needle with two yards of thread with a stop bead, leaving 4" of tail.

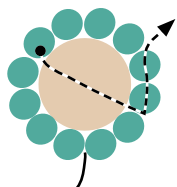
1 Pick up **twelve 11s**. Weave back through the twelve beads to create a circle. Remove the stop bead and tie your tail and working thread to secure. Weave through all the beads again, then two beads past your tail thread.



2 Pick up **one 4mm round**. Slide it to the circle and weave into a bead where your thread is exiting the 4mm (it doesn't matter which direction you head). Continue weaving through the circle until you reach the last bead before your thread entered the circle after the 4mm.

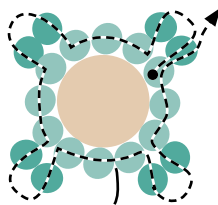


3 Weave back into the 4mm and weave into two seed beads.



4 Pick up **two 11s** and weave into the next three 11s on the circle. Position the new beads so they sit side by side. Repeat this three more times to create four corners on the circle. Exit the first 11 bead added in this step.

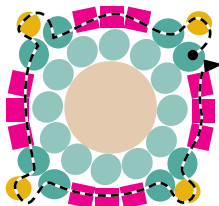
You can now clip your tail.



5 Pick up **one 15** and weave into the 11 beside it. Pick up **three Delicas** and weave into the first 11 in the next corner.

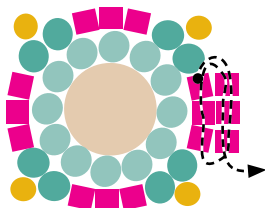
Repeat this step to add one 15 to each corner and Delica strands to each side.

Weave through this thread path again, and exit the first set of Delicas added.

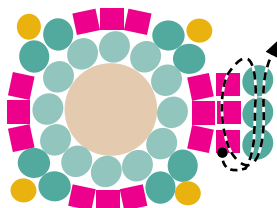


6 Pick up **three Delicas*** and weave into the other end of the Delica set you are exiting. Weave back into the new row. Repeat the thread path and exit the second new row of Delicas.

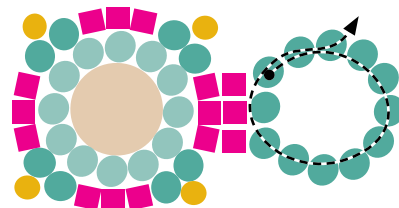
*Pick up the color Delica you plan to use in the next tile.



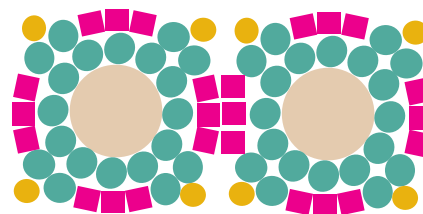
7 Pick up **three 11s** and weave into the other end of the Delica set you are exiting. Weave back into the new row. Repeat the thread path and exit the second new row of 11s.



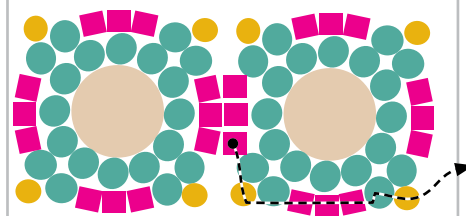
8 Pick up **nine 11s**. Weave into the other end of the 11s set you are exiting. Weave through all twelve beads and exit two beads past the original three 11s.



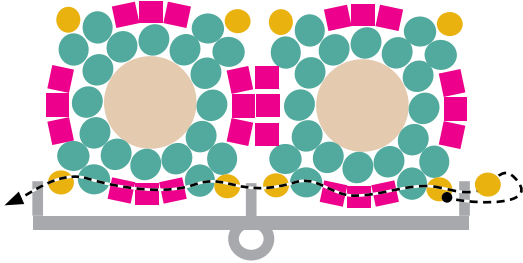
9 Repeat Steps 2 through 5 to create a second component.



10 Weave through to exit any end 15 picot.

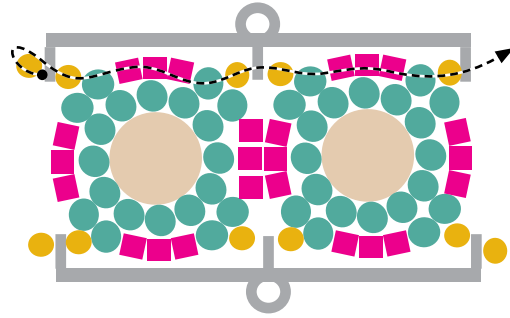


11 Position the Topolia end against the long end of the segment. Weave into the end of the Topolia. Pick up **one 15** and weave back into the Topolia, 15, 11, three Delicas, 11, 15. Weave into the middle connector on the Topolia. Continue weaving through the 15, 11, three Delicas, 11, 15, and other end of the Topolia.

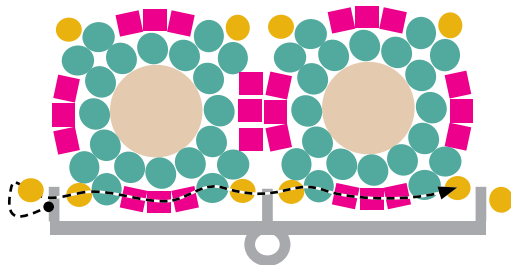


14 Pick up **one 15** and weave back through the edge beads, middle connector, edge beads, and into the end connector of the Topolia.

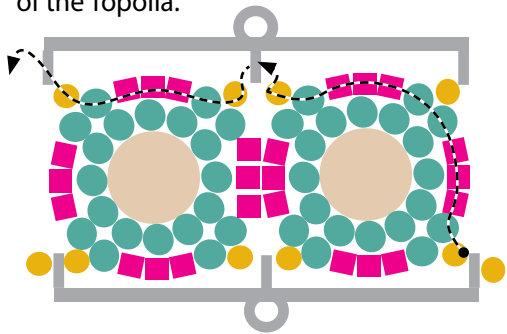
Pick up **one 15**, and repeat the thread path so there is a secure connection to the Topolia end. Secure your thread and clip the excess.



12 Pick up **one 15** and weave back into the Topolia, 15, 11, three Delicas, 11, 15, middle connector, 15, 11, three Delicas, 11, 15. Repeat this thread path so there is a secure connection to the Topolia end,



13 Weave through the edge beads to exit the 15 at the center of the other edge of the segment, Weave into the middle connector of the Topolia, and through the edge beads and into the end of the Topolia.



Connect your segments with jump rings.

If you want to make a segment with four tiles, simply add the tiles using the same steps used to add each tile.
