



'Vannerie' bracelet & earrings

Skill Level: Intermediate

Techniques to know: herringbone, fringe, picot, bead weaving, familiarity with multi-hole beads

Finished size: Bracelet (6.7" x 0.8") Earrings (1.8" x 0.8")

MATERIALS

0.5 grams size 15° seed beads

1 gram size 11° seed beads

1 gram size 8° seed beads

0.5 grams size 11 Delicas

24 x 3mm fire polished rounds

14 grams GemDuo beads

4 KIPOS II Cymbal™ Gemduo endings

2 or 4 x 5mm open jump rings

16mm toggle clasp

Pair of ear wires

4lb. Fireline

size 12 beading needle

Scissors/Pliers

Jeweler's glue

Designer tips

- Check all holes of GemDuo beads to make sure they are clear before stitching.
- Glue the GemDuos to the KIPOS components before starting the work.

Add first KIPOS

Step 1. Use 8' of thread to string a stop bead (red dot), leaving 7" tail. Lay the KIPOS ending face up on your work surface with the holes oriented vertically with the loop at the left. Place a GemDuo inside each leg of the KIPOS (beads 1, 2 and 3). Pass the needle, at the same time, through the holes of the KIPOS and the GemDuos, exiting from the top leg of the KIPOS (red thread). String one 11° and sew back through the KIPOS (same hole) and proceed through all the beads and KIPOS legs to exit from the bottom leg of the KIPOS (blue thread). String one 11° and sew back through the KIPOS and GemDuos. Reverse the thread direction by sewing through the open hole of the end GemDuo (black thread).

Step 2. String one GemDuo (bead 4) and sew through bead 2. String one GemDuo (bead 5) and sew through bead 1 (red thread). String one 11° and sew up through beads 1, 5, 2, 4 and 3 (same holes, blue thread). String one 11° and sew back through beads 4, 2 and 5. Reverse direction by sewing through the open hole of bead 5 (black thread).

Step 3. String one GemDuo (bead 6) and sew up through bead 4.

Step 4. String one 8° and sew back through beads 4, 6 and 5 (same holes, red thread). String one 8° and sew up through beads 5 and 6. Reverse direction by sewing through the open hole bead 6 (blue thread). String one GemDuo (bead 7), one 8° and sew back through beads 7 and 6 (fuchsia thread). String one GemDuo (bead 8), one 8° and sew back through beads 8, 6 and 7 (same holes). Reverse direction by sewing through the open hole of bead 7 (black thread).

Step 5. String one GemDuo (bead 9) and sew through bead 8 (same hole, red thread). String one GemDuo (bead 10), one 11° and sew back through beads 10, 8, 9 and 7 (same holes, blue thread). String a Gemduo (bead 11) an 11° and sew back through beads 11, 7, 9, 8 and 10 (same holes). Reverse direction by sewing through the open hole of bead 10 (black thread).

Step 6. Repeat Steps from 2 to 5 six times; then exit up from the left hole of bead 10.

Add second KIPOS

Step 7. Lay the KIPOS face up on your work surface with the holes oriented vertically and the loop at the right. Pass the needle through the top leg of the KIPOS (red thread). String one 11° and sew back through the KIPOS and beads 10, 9 and 11, exiting from the bottom leg of the KIPOS (blue thread). String one 11° and sew through (same holes) the KIPOS and beads 11, 9 and 10, exiting from the top leg of the KIPOS and 11° (black thread).

Embellishment

Step 8. String three 11°s and sew through next 11° (red thread). String one delica, one 15°, one delica and sew through the next 8° (blue thread). String one 3mm fire polish and sew through the next 8° (green thread). String one delica, one 15°, one delica and sew through the next 11° (black thread).

Step 9. Repeat these stitches to complete this edge of the bracelet, then on the last stitch, add three 11°s, sew through next 11° and sew down through the KIPOS, GemDuos and the bottom 11°.

Step 10. Repeat the embellishment steps on this edge of the bracelet, secure the thread and trim it. Remove the stopper bead from the tail, thread on a needle and sew through several beads. Secure the thread and trim it (not shown for clarity).

Step 11. Use an open jump ring to attach half of the clasp to one end of the bracelet. Repeat on the other end of the bracelet.

Earrings

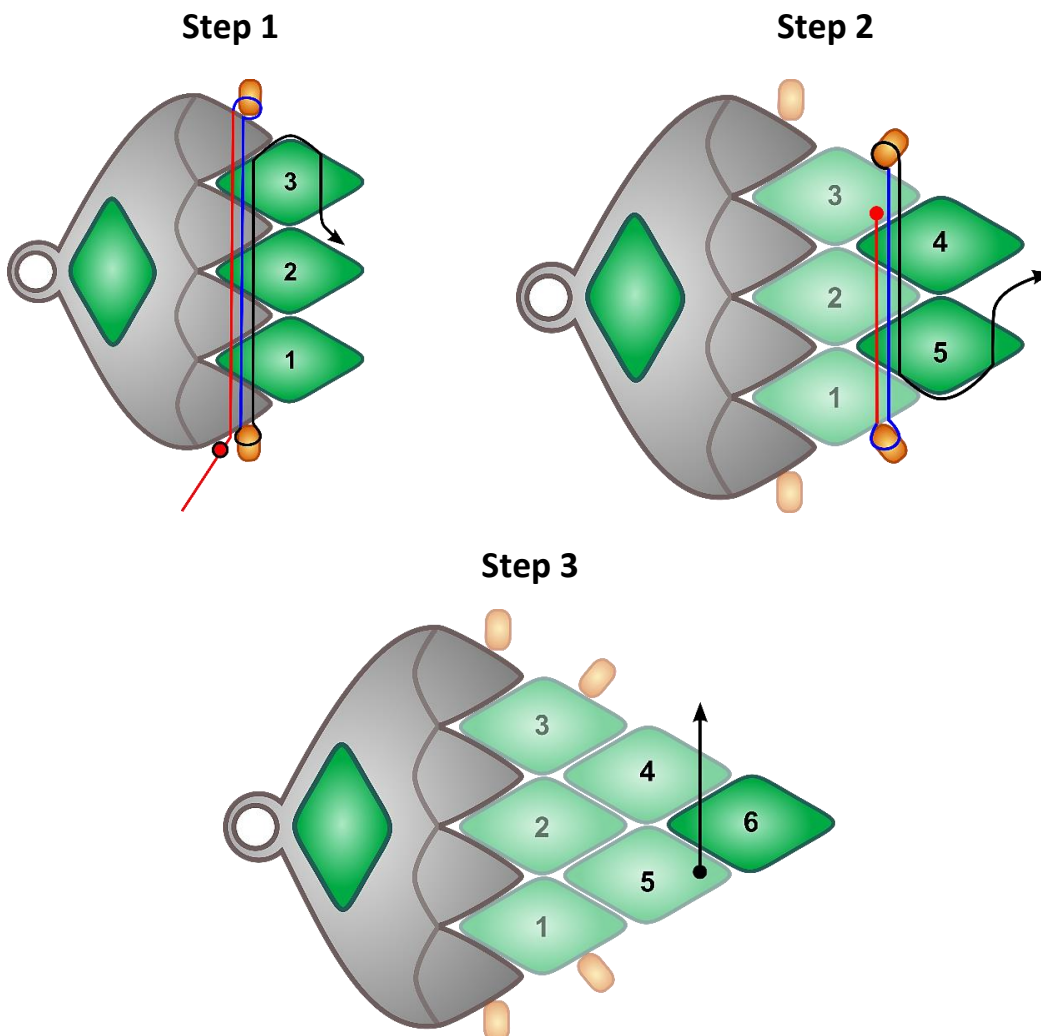
Step 12. Repeat from Steps 2 to 5. Next repeat Steps 2 and 3 to form an earring. Add the embellishment and exit from the bottom hole of bead 6.

Step 13. [a] String three 3mm and sew back through the GemDuo exited (same hole, **red thread**). Repeat the thread path through the three 3mm and exit again from the GemDuo (same hole, **black thread**). [b] String one delica, one 15°, one delica and sew through next 8°. Continue through beads 5, 6, 4 and the next 8° (same holes, **red thread**). String one delica, one 15°, one delica and sew back through bead 6. Repeat the previous thread path to exit from the second unit of beads added in this step (**black thread**). [c] String one 15° and sew through next three 3mm (**red thread**). String one 15° and sew through the next delica, 15°, delica and 8°. Secure the thread and trim it (**black thread**).

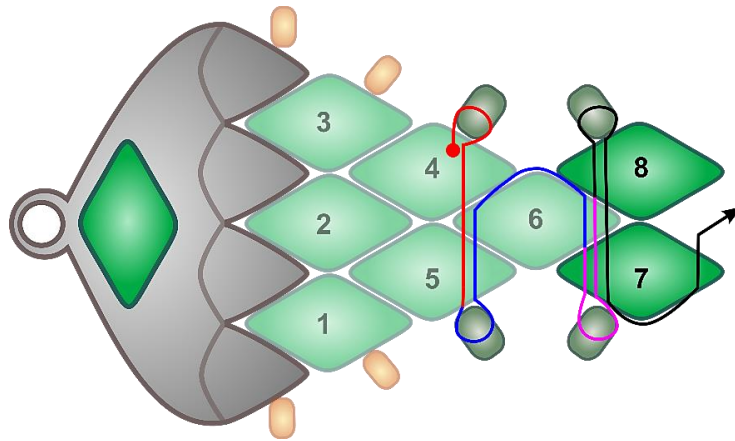
Step 14. Form another earring. Attach an ear wire to each loop of the KIPOS endings to complete the earrings.
