



## WHEEL OF TIME PENDANT

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Make this stylish pendant in a couple hours!

**Project Level:** intermediate and up

**Techniques Used:** bead weaving with multi-hole beads and netting stitch

**Finished Size:** 3 inches in diameter

### MATERIALS

1g size 15° seed beads (SB15)

2g size 11° seed beads (SB11)

12 size 8° (SB8)

6 Bowtie beads

24 Paisley Duos

1 size 14mm rivoli

12 size 3mm fire polish

12 size 4mm crystal bicones

1 Bail of choice

Chain and clasp of choice

6lb. Fireline or D weight beading thread

Size 12 beading needle

Scissors/Pliers

**TIP:** Always check for blocked holes when working with multi-hole beads.

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### FIGURE 1

**Step 1.** Cut and thread 40 inches of Fireline on a needle. String one Bowtie and one 8° six times. Sew through all the beads to form a ring leaving an eight-inch tail. Tie knot both threads. Leave the working thread aside and thread a needle on the tail.

### FIGURE 2

**Step 2.** You should be exiting an 8°. String two 11°s, one 8° and two 11°s and sew through the next 8° in the ring (Fig. 2.1). Go back up the last 11° you just added. String one 11°, one 8°, two 11°s and sew through the next 8° (Fig. 2.2). **NOTE:** Each loop will share an 11° with the loops on either side of it. Repeat four more times. When you come to the last 8°, string one 11°, one 8°, one 11° and sew through the bottom 11° of the first loop added and the first 8° originally exited. Step up to exit the 8° added in this Step 2 (Fig. 2.3).

### FIGURE 3

**Step 3.** String one 11° and sew through the next middle 8° of the previous round. Repeat all the way around the component and reinforce the thread path once more. Tie a couple of half hitch knots and trim the tail thread. The back of the bezel is complete.

### FIGURE 4

**Step 4.** With the working thread exiting an 8° added in Step 1, string three 11°, one 3mm fire polish, three 11°s and sew through the next 8° (Fig. 4.1). Repeat all the way around and step up to exit one 11°, one 3mm and one 11° (Fig. 4.2).

### ADD THE RIVOLI

#### FIGURE 5

**Step 5.** No beads are added in this step. Place the rivoli in the bezel face up and reinforce the thread path twice pulling the thread snug to secure the rivoli (Fig 5.1). Step up and exit the middle hole of the Bowtie (Fig. 5.2).

#### FIGURE 6

**Step 6.** String one Paisley Duo (wide end, concave hole), one Paisley (wide end, convex hole) and sew through the middle hole of the next Bowtie (Fig. 6.1). Repeat all the way around and reinforce the thread path once more. Step up to exit the top hole of the Bow Tie (Fig. 6.2).

#### FIGURE 7

**Step 7.** Continue through the open hole of the next Paisley. String one Paisley (tip end, concave hole), one Paisley (tip end, convex hole) and sew through the next Paisley-Bowtie-Paisley set (Fig. 7.1). Repeat all the way around and reinforce the thread path once more. Step up to exit the Bowtie (Fig. 7.2).

#### FIGURE 8

**Step 8.** String one 15°, one 4mm crystal bicone and sew through the outer hole of the Paisley added in the previous step. String one 3mm and sew through the next Paisley (Fig. 8.1). String one 4mm, one 15° and sew through the next Bowtie (Fig. 8.2). Repeat all the way around and reinforce the thread path once more and step up to exit the 3mm (Fig. 8.3).

## ATTACH THE BAIL

### FIGURE 9

**Step 9.** String three 15°s, the bail, three 15°s and sew through the 3mm. Reinforce the thread path twice and weave in the thread by tying half hitch knots and trim it. Slide the pendant onto your favorite chain.

Your pendant is finished and ready to wear!

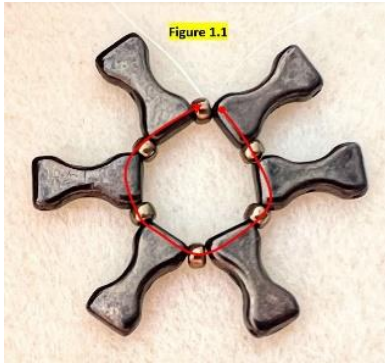

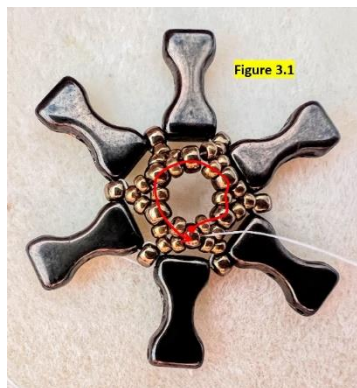

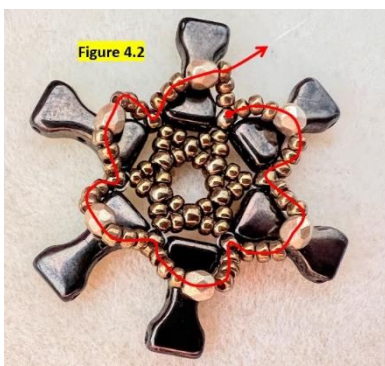

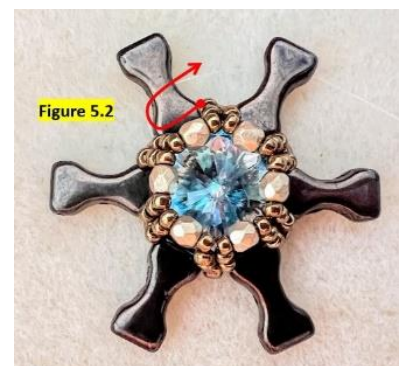

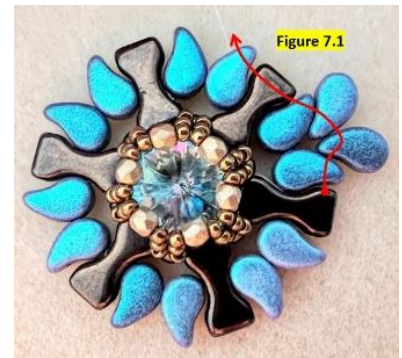

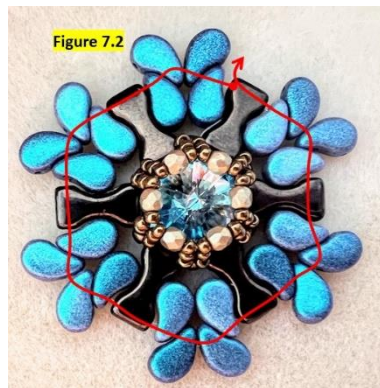

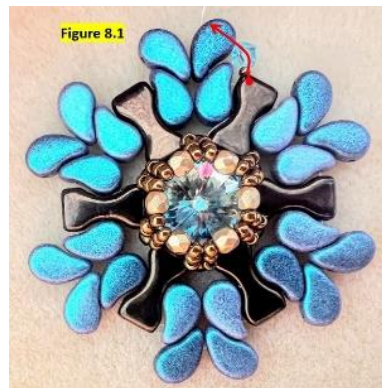
